

NOTICE TO THE PROPERTY OWNER Southend Half Marathon 2025 SUNDAY 8th June 2025

Please note this event will affect you

We would like to take this opportunity to inform you that the annual Southend Half Marathon takes place on Sunday 8th June 2025. The wheelchair race starts from Shoeburyness East Beach at 08:45, followed by the runners. Due to the proximity of the road closures we would like to advise you of the route as follows:

- George St (East)
- Rampart Terrace
- Rampart Street
- Smith Street
- Campfield Rd
- New Garrison Rd
- St Georges Lane
- The Terraces
- Old Warrior Sq Rd
- Magazine Rd
- New Barge Pier Rd
- Ness Rd
- Shoebury Common Rd Seafront
- Seafront Burdett Rd Seafront (loop)
- Maplin Way North
- Church Rd
- Ness Rd
- New Barge Pier Rd
- Pick up footway/cycle path south to Coastal path
- Coastal Path
- Rampart Terrace back to start



The runners at the front of the field will be led by motorcycle. The winner should be finished by approximately 10.10am, with the last runners reaching the finish at East Beach by 12.00pm. The course will be marshalled at all road junctions to ensure the safety of runners.

The Seafront will be closed for the duration of the race from Ness Road to Beach Road (just before the Kursaal).

Church Road and Maplin Way

Church Road and Maplin Way from Church Road to the Seafront will also be closed for the duration of the race from 8.45am to 12.00pm. However, if you must move your car in the direction away from the seafront, marshals will be on hand to assist you and ensure the safety of the participants.

- New Garrison Rd and all roads within the Garrison except New Barge Pier Rd 08.45 10.00 (Rolling Sweepers will open roads as the last runner has passed through Ness Rd)
- Ness Rd (South of Church Rd) Seafront (Turning point) 08.45-12.00
- Maplin Way Church Rd 08.45-12.00
- New Barge Pier Rd (South Magazine Rd) 08.45-12.00

We ask for your patience and support during the race and thank you in anticipation of your help, understanding and cooperation. This race is organised by Havens Hospices. We hope to attract about 2,000 runners and many of them will be raising money for Havens Hospices.
